

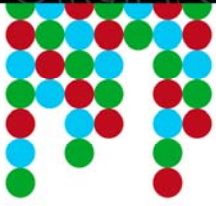
FAQ - Personal Identification Number

Q: What do I need to write against Personal Identification Number in the online Registration form?

A: We require your personal identification number as it is written on your ID/Passport or your home social security number, generally called Tax Identification Numbers (TINs); see below the examples depending on nationality or more information regarding all countries under the link: https://ec.europa.eu/taxation_customs/tin/#/tin-country

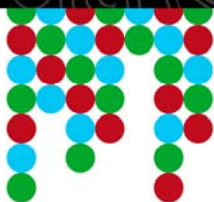

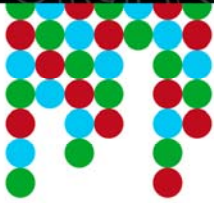
E.g. 6 Serbian personal identification number format is: 000000000000 (13 digits - yellow highlighted below)
